

## Saint Demetrios High School (7-12)

### Supply List for School Year 2022-2023

In order to make it easier for parents and students to do their “BACK TO SCHOOL SHOPPING” at their leisure, the teaching staff at Saint Demetrios High School has updated their supply list for the upcoming year. With COVID19 regulations being modified throughout the state, all students will have access to lockers on various floors in the high school building. Please purchase locks from Ms. Vasso in the middle school office for \$20; all students must have the same school locks- OUTSIDE LOCKS are NOT ALLOWED.

This supply list is NOT all inclusive and teachers may request additional items during the school year.

\*English: 7<sup>th</sup> grade should have a one/one half inch black binder with loose leaf paper and 2 pocket folder. Grades 8-12, a 5 subject notebook with a black cover and a 2 pocket folder.

\*Greek/Greek Studies: 5 subject notebook (preferably white/yellow cover) with pocket folders.

\*Math: Blue (navy or basic) one/one half inch binder divided into Classwork/Homework sections, loose leaf paper, pencils, a graphing calculator for students in grades 9-12, a scientific calculator for students in grades 7-8, graph paper, and a two pocket folder.

\*Science: one/one half inch green binder with loose leaf paper and folder; scientific or graphing calculator for Chemistry and Physics.

\*Social Studies: red cover 3 subject notebook with a 2 pocket folder

It is suggested that all students have a pencil/pen pouch with blue, black pens, pencils, and hi lighters. In addition, personal hygiene items such as hand sanitizer and pocket tissues are also suggested.

Students who are scheduled for Computer Science/Technology, you will be asked to purchase a USB. Students who take gym must purchase t-shirts, sweat pants, sweat shirts from the high school office (\$20 per item). Any student who is scheduled for art or

music will be informed by their teachers as to what special supplies are needed on the first day of classes and additional time will be given to purchase these items.

We kindly ask that students DO NOT bring their supplies to school until they are informed by their teachers.

For the new incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders, please note that high school students wear blue polo shirts (fall and spring), long sleeve blue button down shirts (winter), and the girls may wear gray slacks from November 1-April 30. Uniform items must be purchased from Flynn O' Hara. Please see information on uniforms attached.
