Student Appearance:

Students must appear well groomed and neat every day for school.

Boys must have neat, groomed hair. All hairstyles must be appropriate for a professional setting. The following is general guidance on student appearance in school.

The following is a list of prohibited items:

The following is a non-exhaustive list of prohibited items:

- Hats
- Bandanas
- Large hair/ head accessories
- Distracting accessories (i.e. large plastic glasses)
- Spray-colored hair
- Colored hair clips
- Piercings other than girls' earrings.
- Excessive jewelry
- Heavy or unnatural makeup, both in terms of product and application.
 - o (Examples: bronzer, smoky eyes, highlighters, red lipstick, eyeliner, fake eyelashes, frosted or glittered lipstick, dark and/or low-chromatic colors)
- Nail design
- Clothing which displays or uses offensive or inappropriate pictures, designs or language
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses that are not of appropriate length.
 - o Example of appropriate length:
 - Bermuda length (cut at or below the knee)
 - measured by student arms straight at sides (fingers extended, with fabric measuring even with or longer than, the fingertips.)
- Bare midriff
- Open toed shoes (Flip flops, slides, or slippers)
- Crocs or sandals
- Ripped Clothing
- Excessively saggy pants (i.e. pants that sag below the waist, etc.)
- Leggings

The administration has the final determination on dress code violations.

A neat and groomed appearance includes but is not limited to:

- Uniform shirts tucked in
- Shoes shined
- Clothing ironed

Boys' Uniform

Boys' All-Year Attire:

Upper wear:

- Light blue dress shirt with long sleeves/school logo
- Necktie
- Navy blue blazer (required during full uniform)
- V-Neck Sweater (optional)
- Cardigan (optional)

Lower wear:

- Gray trousers
- Black or beige crew socks
- Plain black or brown leather belt
- Black or brown dress shoes (no sneakers, Uggs, etc.)

Boys' Summer Uniform Option

*The following option(s) may be used as an option in addition to the "all-year attire".
The option(s) may **only** be worn from April 15th through October 15th.*

- Light blue polo shirts

Boys' Full Uniform

Must be worn during assemblies and church services.

- Light blue dress shirt with long sleeves/school logo
- School tie
- Navy Blue Blazer
- Gray trousers
- Black crew socks
- Plain black or plain brown leather belt
- Black or brown leather dress shoes (no sneakers, Uggs, etc.)

Boys' Gym Uniform

*Gym uniform must be brought to school on days when class has gym class.
Students will change at the start and end of gym class.*

Upper wear:

- Saint Demetrios T-Shirt
- Saint Demetrios Sweatshirt

Lower Wear:

- Saint Demetrios sweatpants
- Saint Demetrios shorts
- Sneakers

Girls' Uniform

Girls' All-Year Attire:

Upper Wear:

- Light blue dress shirt with long sleeves & school logo
- Navy Blue Blazer (required during full uniform)
- V-Neck Sweaters (optional)

Lower Wear:

- Gray skort
- Gray slacks
- Black or navy-blue knee-high socks
- Black or navy-blue tights
- Black or brown leather dress shoes (no sneakers, Uggs, etc.)

Girls' Summer Uniform Option:

The following items may be used as an option in addition to the "all-year attire".

*The option(s) may **only** be worn from April 15th through October 15th.*

- Light blue polo shirts, in lieu of the light blue dress shirt.

Girls' Full Uniform:

Must be worn during assemblies and church services

- Light blue dress shirt with long sleeve/school logo
- Navy Blue Blazer (required during full uniform)
- Gray skort
- Black or Navy-blue knee-high socks
- Black tights or navy-blue tights
- Black or brown leather dress shoes (no sneakers, Uggs, etc.)

Girls' Gym Uniform:

*Gym uniform must be brought to school on days when class has gym class.
Students will change at the start and end of gym class.*

Upper wear:

- Saint Demetrios T-Shirt
- Saint Demetrios Sweatshirt

Lower Wear:

- Saint Demetrios sweatpants
- Saint Demetrios shorts
- Sneakers

Gym Locker Room

All belongings must be removed from the gym locker room by the student at the end of every scheduled gym period. The gym locker room will be cleared with great regularity and frequency. The school is not responsible for any items left behind by students for any length of time following the gym period.
